- Please note some athletes may be selected in both the Coupe and Home International teams as deemed necessary by the HPD and Lead Coaches.
- Some athletes selected in sculling boats may be named in a sweep boat and vice-versa.

For Junior Men there will be a minimum of 3 sculling places and 5 pair places available at Cork Regatta depending on selection decisions for World Championship crews and overlapping of crews between Homes and Coupe.
