BOARD SUB-COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

Offshore Committee

1. Composition

The Offshore committee consists of a Chair and a minimum of five other members. Others with particular expertise may be invited to attend meetings as required.

2. Appointment

The Chair is appointed annually by the Board of Rowing Ireland. Four additional members are elected at the Annual Delegate Meeting of the Offshore clubs. The host club of the Irish Offshore Championships will appoint a further member.

3. Purpose

To organise, develop and promote Offshore (FISA Coastal) rowing in Ireland in a safe and fair manner.

4. Functions

- a) To encourage the growth of Offshore Rowing in Ireland
- b) To set standards for Offshore rowing in Ireland
- c) To ensure the Irish Offshore Championships are run to a safe and high standard
- d) To approve entries for the FISA World Coastal Championships
- e) To develop a series of Offshore regattas
- f) To develop minimum standards for regattas
- g) To develop safe practices for Offshore rowing in conjunction with the Safety Committee
- h) To promote coach education in conjunction with the Coach Education Officer
- i) To train and if necessary examine marshals and umpires
- j) Provide regular updates to the Board of rowing as necessary
- k) The Chair to liaise with the CEO as necessary
- l) The Chair to liaise with FISA and other Federations as necessary
- m) Any other tasks allocated by the Board of Rowing Ireland

5. Meeting Frequency

Minimum of four meetings per annum.



6. Board Reporting

The Committee will report twice per annum and their report should contain the following:

- Dates of what meetings have been held and attendance
- Plan of activities and objectives for the year
- Summary of activities since the last report
- Any actions requiring Board attention
