



Irish Rowing Championships – NRC 2019

Volunteer Manager Required

The Irish Rowing Championships are the highlight of the domestic rowing season. This event, which is both volunteer led and volunteer delivered, requires a large number of volunteers to deliver the high quality event that our athletes deserve.

To assist in the recruitment and management of the various volunteers we are looking to recruit a Volunteer Manager. The details of the requirements are set out below. Please consider supporting Rowing Ireland by applying for this position.

Duties – The position requires recruitment in advance of the regatta and a support/management role during the regatta. Details are as follows:

In Advance: Recruiting Launch drivers, volunteer doctors, stakeboat personnel and other volunteers in conjunction with other members of the Championship committee.

During the Regatta: Acting as a meeting point for new arrivals, providing them with their volunteer shirt, acting as coordinator for the team of volunteers working at the regatta.

Requirements – Previous experience in running a rowing event would be beneficial but is not essential.

Dates required – The main requirements are during the days of competition which are Friday 12th to Sunday 14th July. Much of the preparation will be done in advance and it would be beneficial if the Volunteer Manager was on site from the Thursday.

This is an unpaid volunteer position but the successful candidate will be provided with meals throughout the event and will also receive a souvenir polo-shirt. Accommodation will be provided throughout the event.
