- To help with the running of camps and events relating to the project (if necessary)
- To support events associated with the Get Going Get Rowing programme
- To have the ability to work and liaise with both teachers, participants and programme partners
- To work closely with the Cork Rowing Development Officer
- To log and record all class numbers for evaluation and monitoring purposes
