Rowing Ireland is the national governing body for the sport of Rowing across the island of Ireland. To build the next chapter we are seeking suitably qualified individuals for up to three Coach roles. The Coach will work as part of the High-Performance Team to effectively maximise the performance outcomes for Rowing Ireland Team crews across all categories.

In this role you will:

- Support the Implementation of Rowing Ireland's High-Performance Strategy.
- Support the development of Rowing Ireland's High-Performance System in line with the Rowing Ireland High-Performance Director (HPD) by being part of leading the Men, Women or the Pathway program.
- Support Rowing Ireland's Squad of Coaches in organising and developing their respective squads to deliver sustainable podium competitive performance in International Competition and for Olympic Games.
- Conduct daily training at the National Rowing Centre under the direction of the HPD.

Essential Skills and Experience Required

- A strong team player with excellent communication skills and the ability to build and maintain relationships with coaches, athletes and support staff
- High level of personal initiative and autonomy
- Proven track record of coaching successful crews
- Experience in the delivery of podium capable crews
- Experience in coaching multiple crews (including gender and boat class diversity)
- 3+ years' experience in international rowing coaching, or other relevant coaching experience
