## Introduction

The Irish Rowing 1K Classic committee will run the 2023 Classic Regatta on the 1st of July 2023 at the National Rowing Centre in Cork. In accordance with the rules of Rowing Ireland. This Regatta is a Non-Status event.

All events will be run on a 1,000-meter course.

Closing date for entries is 7.00 pm on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June.



## Entries

*Entries must be made through Tracker by 19:00 on  
Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June.*

Entry fees are €12 per seat (incl cox) for all events.

Payment of entry fees may be made by debit/credit card using the Rowing Ireland online payments system.

Payment must be made in full before the close of entry.

If not paying electronically, please note that your complete entry fee must reach the office of Rowing Ireland by COB on Wednesday 21st June. No entry fees will be accepted at the event.

No entries will be accepted after the deadline. An entry will be invalid if entry fees are not paid before the deadline and clubs are responsible for ensuring that entry fees are received before the deadline.

Races will be run under Rowing Ireland rules and entries will only be accepted from Clubs which were affiliated to Rowing Ireland on 1<sup>st</sup> March, in respect of athletes who were registered with Rowing Ireland, for the relevant club, on 1<sup>st</sup> June.

Every effort has been made to ensure the 1-hour rule for juniors is observed. Where rowers compete in boats above their grades, breaching this rule is the club's and coaches' responsibility alone.
